



Bend FC Timbers Soccer Complex Rules

To make the most of your experience and to keep the facility looking and playing beautifully for many years to come, here are a few guidelines to facilitate everyone's enjoyment at Bend FC Timbers Soccer Complex:

- Do not climb on fences or other structures not designated for climbing.
- All litter and garbage must be disposed of properly. Tape, water bottles, clothing, pre-wrap, etc. must be removed from the fields or the sidelines. Trash cans are placed throughout Pine Nursery Park and there is a dumpster available for your convenience located on the southwest side of the park.
- Animals are not allowed inside the complex.
- Food, beverage (except water), sunflower seeds, gum, peanuts, and similar food are NOT allowed on the synthetic fields.
- To avoid possible damage to electrical, irrigation, and water lines, Bend FC Timbers requires that canopy equipment, temporary structures, etc. (10x10' and smaller) be secured with water or sand weights. No stakes are permitted.
- Metal and/or steel spikes are prohibited on synthetic fields.
- No smoking or vaping allowed.
- No motorized vehicles allowed on synthetic turf or perimeter pathway.
- Do not kick, throw, or otherwise propel objects into the fencing.
- Bend FC Timbers is not responsible for the security of personal items.
- Leave immediately after scheduled use safely and quietly. For the benefit of the community, please practice being good neighbors in residential neighborhoods.
- No tarps or material which may damage the turf or perimeter landscape may be used.
- Field use must be suspended in the event thunder and/or lightning is observed, following USYS lightning guidelines. Bend FC Timbers staff will make the final determination as to the playability of fields.
