



Bend FC Timbers Soccer Complex: Rules for Turf Use

In order to make the most of your experience and to keep the facility looking and playing beautifully for many years to come, here are a few guidelines to facilitate everyone's enjoyment at Bend FC Timbers Soccer Complex:

- Animals, food, or beverages (except water) are prohibited on the synthetic turf. Sunflower seeds, gum, peanuts, and similar food items are NOT allowed on the fields.
- Similarly, metal and/or steel spikes are prohibited on the synthetic fields.
- Do not kick, throw or otherwise propel objects into the fencing.
- Certificate of Insurance required.
- Weapons are prohibited.
- Criminal activity is prohibited.
- No smoking or vaping allowed on synthetic fields.
- Groups must be off the field by the time their reservation period ends so the next group can take the field and make the most of their allotted time.
- No motorized vehicles allowed on synthetic turf.
- Field use must be suspended in the event thunder and/or lightning is observed, in accordance with USYS lightning policy.
- BFCT staff will make the final determination as to the playability of the fields.
- Users are required/responsible to lock perimeter fence after use.
- **Groups must clean up after themselves; do not leave tape, water bottles, pre-wrap, etc on the fields or the sidelines.**
